## Cas Gasí



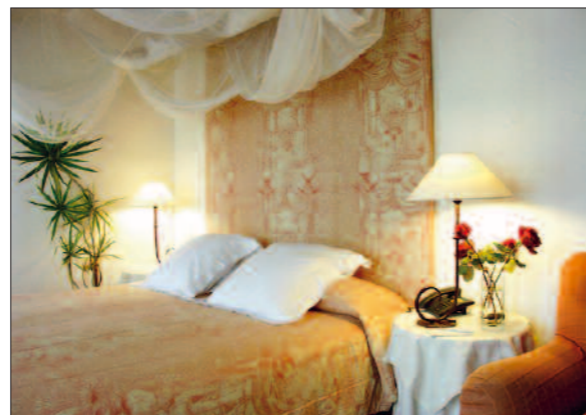
The town of Ibiza is better known as a hotbed for trendy young clubbers in search of dance-till-dawn fun. Beach resorts abound, drawing hordes of party travellers who revel in the festive atmosphere. However, if you're not that sort of traveller, yet are headed to the Spanish island, there is a pocket of tranquillity that you could call your own for the length of your stay.

Just 12 minutes away from Ibiza, Cas Gasí is an oasis of calm, surrounded by lush orchards, olive groves and fragrant fruit trees. This 19<sup>th</sup>-century manorial hacienda is all traditional stonewalls with a brilliant whitewashed façade. Typical of a house of its time, it oozes rustic charm with flora adding splashes of bright, happy colour.

Its owners, Margaret von Korff and Luis Trigueros, acquired the house several years ago and have taken great care to maintain the authenticity of a typical Mediterranean home. Warm hues of cream, blue, ochre and lime are paired against wooden beams, hand-painted tiles and Moroccan-style carpets. Every room bears its own little surprises, from antique furniture to local handicrafts. All are immaculately decorated, with beautiful brass beds, hand-painted wall tiles and terracotta tile floors.

Even the geography of the house has been well thought out—the summer sun reigns here, while winter winds are kept at bay. In the hot season, guests lounge on the porches and terraces, taking in the bucolic view while basking in the sun. When the temperature dips, there is nothing like the toasty warmth of the living rooms and its roaring fireplace.

Like a country resort, Cas Gasí boasts two swimming pools at different levels, each hugged by verdant garden terraces. From here, guests can gaze at Sa Talaia, the island's only mountain. Breakfast is taken on the terrace, while dinner should be ordered in advance if you intend on partaking of the delicious fresh produce picked straight from the hotel's own organic vegetable garden.

With Ibiza just a stone's throw away, guests can take advantage of the sights and attractions, which include the fine beaches and quaint towns nearby. Otherwise, they would do just as well relaxing in the hotel and enjoying a languorous massage, steeping in the hotel's whirlpool or reading a book in its very well-stocked library.

If the mood strikes, there is nothing to stop you from heading to a throbbing nightclub in Ibiza to dance the night away. The best part of the evening will be knowing that when you return to Cas Gasí, peace and quiet will undoubtedly be restored.
